

<a href="#">Wordle</a>		<p>Wordle is a toy for generating “word clouds” from text that you provide. The clouds give greater prominence to words that appear more frequently in the source text. You can tweak your clouds with different fonts, layouts, and color schemes. The images you create with Wordle are yours to use however you like. You can print them out, or save them to the Wordle gallery to share with your friends.</p>	Click <a href="#">here</a>
<a href="#">Tagxedo</a>		<p><a href="#">Tagxedo</a> turns words -- famous speeches, news articles, slogans and themes, even your love letters -- into a visually stunning tag cloud, words individually sized appropriately to highlight the frequencies of occurrence within the body of text.</p>	Click <a href="#">here</a>
<a href="#">Dipity</a>		<p>Dipity is a free and easy way to create a high quality infographic. You can present complex information quickly and clearly without any knowledge of programming or design.</p>	Click <a href="#">here</a>
<a href="#">WallWisher</a>		<p><a href="#">Wallwisher</a> is an electronic stickies program which emulates the paper version on which it is based. Permitting only 160 characters of text – the same as an SMS message – it doesn’t let you write reams. What it <b>does</b> allow you to do is insert pictures and choose the background colour.
