- Honor/Honor with Distinction Student Checklists need to be turned in to Mrs. Jarvis TODAY if you have not already done so.
- If you are taking Health, PE or A & H in credit recovery instead of in your schedule, remember your goal is to be complete by Thanksgiving. If you aren't finished by the end of this semester, you may have your schedule changed and it will be added.
- Seniors taking a class in credit recovery b/c you failed it, you must finish it in order to graduate. You should finish asap so you don't have to stress over it next semester.

### HOW TO REQUEST YOUR TRANSCRIPT

You need to request your transcript through Parchment when you apply for college and again when you graduate. To do this, go to the Laurel County web page, Schools, North Laurel, Guidance, then click the blue link in the center of the page that says, "request my transcript". From there, you create your account and then you will be able to sign in and request your transcript.

Also, don't forget that many college specific scholarship deadlines are December 1. Make sure you don't miss out on money by missing the deadline.
