

After School Child Care Attendance Policy Johnson Elementary Family Resource & Youth Service Center

Definition of After School Child Care Attendance

After School Child Care Attendance defines who may attend the program sponsored by the Johnson Elementary Family Resource Center.

Procedures for After School Child Care Attendance

After school child care will only be provided only when school is in session. The program will not be offered on snow days or when school is released early. Children must be picked up only by persons listed on the child's emergency card on file in the principal's office.

Criteria for After School Care Attendance

Only students attending Johnson Elementary School (preschool through 5th grade), or students who are assigned to Johnson Elementary School (Headstart/Preschool) may attend the After School Child Care program. This plan is subject to council approval, and is administered by the FRYSC Director. Once approved, the plan will remain in effect until changed or modified by the council.

Communication

The Johnson Elementary School After School Child Care Attendance Policy is posted in the registration and sign-out book kept in the school library, and utilized each day by after school care staff. Hourly rates and guidelines of the program are sent to each newly registered participant.

Implementation

The Johnson Family Resource & Youth Service Center Director is responsible for implementation and communication of this policy.
