# Elementary Exit Criteria

## Academic Grade Level Exit Criteria

Laurel County is implementing new K-3 Academic Grade Level Exit Criteria for the 2013-2014 school year. The Laurel County Academic Grade Level Exit Criteria Form will be completed at the end of the school year to determine the progress a child has made during the year, as well as, eligibility for exiting a current grade level.

The Academic Grade Level Exit Criteria will be sent home at the end of the first semester with "**A First Semester Update**". Your child's progress will be evaluated by their teacher and their progress will be scored by a mark entered in the corresponding box that indicates his/her academic performance for the first semester. This will inform you as to the progress your child has made toward reaching the required exit criteria for their current grade level.



## Helpful Suggestions

The education process requires the continuous participation of parent involvement to ensure student's academic success. The following list includes suggestions you may do at home with your child:

- Keep in touch with your child's teacher to monitor their progress
- Monitor your child's grades on Infinite Campus Parent Portal.
- Discuss with your child the importance of following the school's behavior expectations.
- Check your child's homework assignments.
- Read to your child and/or require him/her to read at least 20 minutes daily.
- Show the importance of learning math by helping your child connect math with daily life.
- Promote good daily attendance
